Restaurant and Food Purveyors Must Recycle Solid Waste in 2015

Keeping food and food waste out of the garbage will be mandatory for all Metro Vancouver businesses and institutions by January 1, 2015. Food and food waste are often referred to as organics or green as well as baked goods and prepared, processed and frozen foods. scrapings, paper napkins and bags, uncoated paper cups and plates, and toothpicks. Attention Produce Stores and Eateries

As of January 1, 2015 it will be against the law to mix organics with other garbage. This will especially affect food related businesses. The approved bylaw amendments restrict the disposal of food waste with garbage and require that all holders of business licenses, and ownwaste is disposed of according to that plan.
