

New B-Line Bus Service Slated for Kerrisdale

TransLink is working with the City of Vancouver to introduce a new 'B-Line or Better' bus service along 41st Avenue between UBC and Joyce-Collingwood Station. This new transit route is scheduled to open in autumn 2019. The proposed service changes include replacing Bus Route 43 with the new B-Line bus service and modifying the existing Bus Routes 41 and 49, with more frequent service (every 3-6 minutes in peak times; every 8-10 minutes at other times) and real-time arrival information at each stop. City of Vancouver and TransLink staff will be at the December KBA Board meeting to discuss more details with Directors. Public consultation will follow.
