

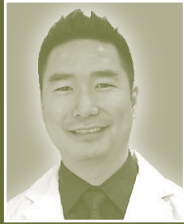

## Kerrisdale Parkade – Two Hour Limit – Registration Required

As many are aware, the Village Parkade is in fact owned by the City of Vancouver who ten months ago shifted the parkade's operation to their own parking division, ***Easy Park***. Recently Easy Park installed parking meters as they eventually will be charging for parking. At present all vehicles using the parkade must be **registered**, for **free**, which will cover the **first 2 hours**. If shoppers are exceeding 2 hours they will need to return to pay for additional time or be issued a ticket. There are meters at the parkade entrances and on the upper level adjacent to the stairwell.
