Getting Charged Up



The City of Vancouver/BC Hydro recently added some Electric Vehicle super power chargers along the Arbutus Greenway at 5575 West Boulevard. This is in keeping with their Greenest City initiative and a boon for anyone wishing to charge up while shopping or working in Kerrisdale Village. These are DC 50KW chargers meaning you can power up in about 15-20 minutes. As of May there will be a fee of 21 cents per minute plus whatever it costs to park in the City owned lot. On another note, the COV is planning to add a modest substation near the Point Grey Secondary School along the Arbutus Greenway to reduce diesel generators that are used for frequent filming in this area. This would also allow access to power for a possible MOBI Bike station or future KBA events.

Litter – We Are in it Together
