Kerrisdale's Iconic Sequoia Tree Transformed

To everyone's disappointment, the iconic Sequoia tree in the 2300 Block of West 41st succumbed and was taken down by the property owner in early 2019.



Your KBA negotiated with the owner for an 18 foot piece of the tree from the butt end (71 inches across). The milled lumber was donated to the Magee Secondary School Shop. Under the expert instruction of teacher Andrew Robinson (last year's KBA Citizen of the Year) several gorgeous items have been crafted for sale with donations going to the school.
